Those in the literary categories should submit, on paper, examples of their writing.

An applicant may apply for up to two (2) scholarships in any year. If you are applying in more than one category, you must submit a separate application for each scholarship, including a complete set of all supporting material for each category. There are different jurors for each category and each must receive a complete application.

Clearly identify yourself if you are a member of a group ensemble. Preferably your performance sample will showcase the applicant.

Include the name and date of publication on any photocopied published material such as reviews or journal publications.

DO NOT send original works of art. Support materials will not be returned.

Keep the following in mind as support material is selected and arranged:

- The SSCF's computers are Windows based and the USB thumb drive must be compatible.
- The SSCF makes every effort to handle support materials safely, however, it is not responsible for the loss of any material.

## 6. General

The Larry Wilson Scholarships are paid yearly for the purpose of providing scholarships to deserving, talented students who are 17 years of age and over, who have permanent residence in Moose Jaw or the South Saskatchewan Enterprise Region.

The South Saskatchewan Community Foundation (hereinafter SSCF) reserves the right to grant more than one (1) scholarship in each discipline each year but in no event will a scholarship be less than \$500.00 per year.

The Wilson Scholarships are to be used first to the cost of enrollment and, if any excess, to be applied to enrollment-related expenses. Requests for excess funding to be carried over to the next school year may be considered upon written request.

The SSCF reserves the right to not grant a scholarship in any discipline.
